Readings for 12th January 2025:

Baptism Of Christ

Old Testament Reading: Psalm 139: 1 – 6

¹O Lord, You have searched me and known me! ² You know when I sit down and when I rise up; You discern my thoughts from afar. ³ You search out my path and my lying down and are acquainted with all my ways. Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, O Lord, You know it altogether. ⁵ You hem me in, behind and before, and lay Your hand upon me. ⁶ Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high; I cannot attain it.

New Testament Reading: Acts 8: 14 – 17

¹⁴Now when the apostles at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent to them Peter and John, ¹⁵who came down and prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Spirit, ¹⁶ for He had not yet fallen on any of them, but they had only been baptised in the name of the Lord Jesus. ¹⁷Then they laid their hands on them and they received the Holy Spirit.

Gospel Reading:

Luke 3: 15 – 18 & 21 – 2

¹⁵As the people were filled with expectation and all were questioning in their hearts concerning John, whether he might be the Christ, ¹⁶John answered them all, saying, "I baptise you with water, but He who is mightier than I is coming, the strap of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and with fire. ¹⁷His winnowing fork is in His hand, to clear His threshing floor and to gather the wheat into His barn, but the chaff He will burn with unquenchable fire." ¹⁸So with many other exhortations he preached good news to the people. ...

²¹Now when all the people were baptised and when Jesus also had been baptised and was praying, the heavens were opened ²²and the Holy Spirit descended on Him in bodily form, like a dove; and a voice came from heaven: "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."
